

ABCs of Photo Organizing



Ways to get started in organizing your photos. One of the best ways to organize your photos is the ABCs method. When you are sorting your photos, you can put them into these four different piles.

Album - These are the best of the best; they are album worthy. These are the photos you want to digitize, save and share. You might also want to put them online to share with family and friends.

Box – These are the photos that are the extras that support your best photos. You aren't ready to part with them. These photos will be archived for safekeeping but will not be digitized.

Can – These are the doubles and duds or ones that don't fit into the other two categories. Be strong...these photos will go in the trashcan. If that is much for you, they can go into a box labeled with the date it is sealed. If you don't open the box within a year, you know you don't need them and can throw the box away.

Story – These are the special photos that tell a story that is important to remember. They might not be the most perfect photo but it's the only one that shows your daughter and the long scratch on her face as she holds her new baby kitten.

Using the proven ABCs method of organizing will make the arduous task of sorting your photo much easier.
